



EGF 2018 Master Class

A Grazing Master Class will be provided, free of charge, to the recipients of the EGF 2018 Early Stage Researcher Grants. The Master Class will be combined with EGF Working Group Grazing.

When: Sunday 17th June 2018 (Depart 08:00 – return 17:00)

Location: Teagasc, Moorepark (transport by bus will be arranged from EGF 2018 Conference Venue (Rochestown Park Hotel) to Moorepark)

Theme: Maximising grazing in ruminant production systems

It will provide a mixture of theory and practise. In the morning a series of short presentations will be made, and there will be plenty time for discussion. In the afternoon delegates will visit the research farm at Moorepark to experience in-field infrastructure, pre- and post-grazing covers, tools, etc. The objective of the Master class is to inform delegates of the importance of maximising grazing to increase profit, in terms of money or in terms of ecosystem services.
